What everyone should know.

- 1. Yarm Methodist Church is poorly ventilated and so no one who feels unwell should attend church and put others at risk.
- 2. Sharing a car with anyone outside of your family 'bubble' to travel to church is not recommended.
- Upon arrival please wait outside church until the steward calls you to enter. YOU MAY NEED TO DRESS ACCORDINGLY. Maintain social distancing when queueing.
- 4. To safeguard worshippers a temperature gun will be used prior to entry.
- 5. REGRETABLY ONCE THE MUCH REDUCED CAPACITY HAS BEEN REACHED, NO ONE ELSE CAN BE ALLOWED TO ENTER CHURCH. YOU MAY BE TURNED AWAY.
- 6. Face masks must be put on prior to entering the church.
- 7. Everyone must give their contact details to the steward as they enter the church.
- 8. Everyone must use a hand sanitizer on entry and as they leave the building.
- 9. A seat number will be allocated to everyone on entry. If you are fit and able please consider choosing to sit upstairs.
- 10. Everyone must make their way to their allocated seat without delay using the one way system, which must be strictly adhered to.
- 11. Anyone needing the toilet must pass through the church using the one way system and re-enter church to find their seat.
- 12. The toilet for the disabled will be used, as it controls social distancing (no locks exist on main toilet entry doors).

10. If anyone wishes to place money on a collection plate one will be found outside the inner church doors downstairs or halfway up the stairs. 11. No congregational singing is allowed.

12. Everyone should avoid conversation until outside church and then still maintain social distancing.

13. After the service everyone should remain in their seat until a steward invites them to leave (similar to being invited to the communion rail).

14. The minister will not be available for consultation on Sunday mornings and should be contacted by telephone or e mail.
